Building

Built in 1906, International House once served as home to the world's first international trade center. The classic, timelessly beautiful Beaux-Arts-style building has enjoyed three distinct incarnations, serving each time as both a leading local institution and an international destination. In keeping with its well-preserved architecture, the building's classically proportioned façade greet guests with monumental doors, white columns, elegant pediments, and handcrafted gas lanterns. The design approach is that of the minimalist, using restraint and allowing the hotel's natural gifts to speak for themselves.

Location

Situated in New Orleans's Central Business District (CBD), on the corner of Camp and Gravier Streets. The CBD harbors many architectural treasures that have been restored as restaurants, banks and museums. A number of the beloved establishments that have kept people coming to New Orleans for generations are only footsteps away from the front door of International House. International House is a mere two blocks from the French Quarter.

Rooms

Each of the 117 rooms, suites, and penthouses is designed to uplift the human spirit. Spacious bathrooms, architectural artifacts, complimentary 100meg WiFi, Sony and Sharp LCD televisions, iHome micro-stereos, Modern Fan Company fans and Aveda bath amenities, as well as furnishings, linens and color palettes selected by designer LM Pagano create sexy, sophisticated, soothing spaces for sleep, work, and play. Penthouses include landscaped terraces overlooking the French Quarter and Mississippi

River. The hotel is entirely smoke-free.

Lobby

Soaring 23' ceilings define the gracious and airy space that is the International House lobby. In a uniform tone of palest grey, the restrained neo-classical architecture with its moldings and ornate pilasters, and the cool travertine marble floor with broad inlays of indigenous oak, create an atmosphere of calm and soothing geometry, a starkly pure backdrop for the plush and inviting seating arrangements in deep carnelian velvets, anchored by a monumental ottoman. The backlit front desk with a woven steel face inspired by windblown Louisiana irises evokes the delicate tracery of wrought iron. Overhead, three massive chandeliers constructed by a local artisan feature a stylized *ristra*: the pepper bundles that have hung from the rafters of the city's French Market for generations. Singular furnishings, rich in age and character, hint at the ritual and religiosity of New Orleans. Distinctly soulful music, from pop to local artisans, pays tribute to the city's culture.

Bar

Set to a mesmerizing backdrop of flickering candlelight, named for the divine spirits in Voodoo and serving imaginative spirits from small batch distilleries and vineyards, **loa** is a destination bar. It has become a nightly gathering place for creative local artisans and entrepreneurs flocking to the city in unprecedented numbers. "Spirit Handler" Alan Walter can be found behind the bar among a variety of fresh herbs, floral, and other vegetation that lend to his apothecary-like operation. Alan's nearly twenty propriety aromatic syrups contribute to his "Potations" and "Preparations" – inventive concoctions that are served in delicate vintage glassware, linking you to New Orleans' colorful past with each sip.
