<b>Menu</b>	The menu showcases no frills beach-inspired eats and island-style drinks. After years as the spirit-representative for a number of the area's most buttoned-up dining rooms, Thrasher is taking a breezier approach here – he wants his guests to do one thing and one thing only: <i>Have a Blast!</i>
<b>Venue</b>	Potomac Distilling Company houses a three-story Polynesian-style Tiki bar, Tiki TNT, which draws inspiration from countless rum-sodden scuba diving adventures throughout the South Pacific and West Indies during Thrasher's time as a dive master and instructor. The complex houses the urban rum distillery, which produces four varieties



of Thrasher’s Rum – White, Spiced, Coconut, and Green Spiced, a one-of-a-kind botanical blend made to impart flavors of gin with herbs grown on the distillery’s rooftop garden. The three-story restaurant space transports diners to remote islands – guests enter beneath floating Tiki huts and past a bamboo host stand, into an airy space decorated with banana leaf wall coverings, and colorful floor-to-ceiling skull and totem pole murals.
